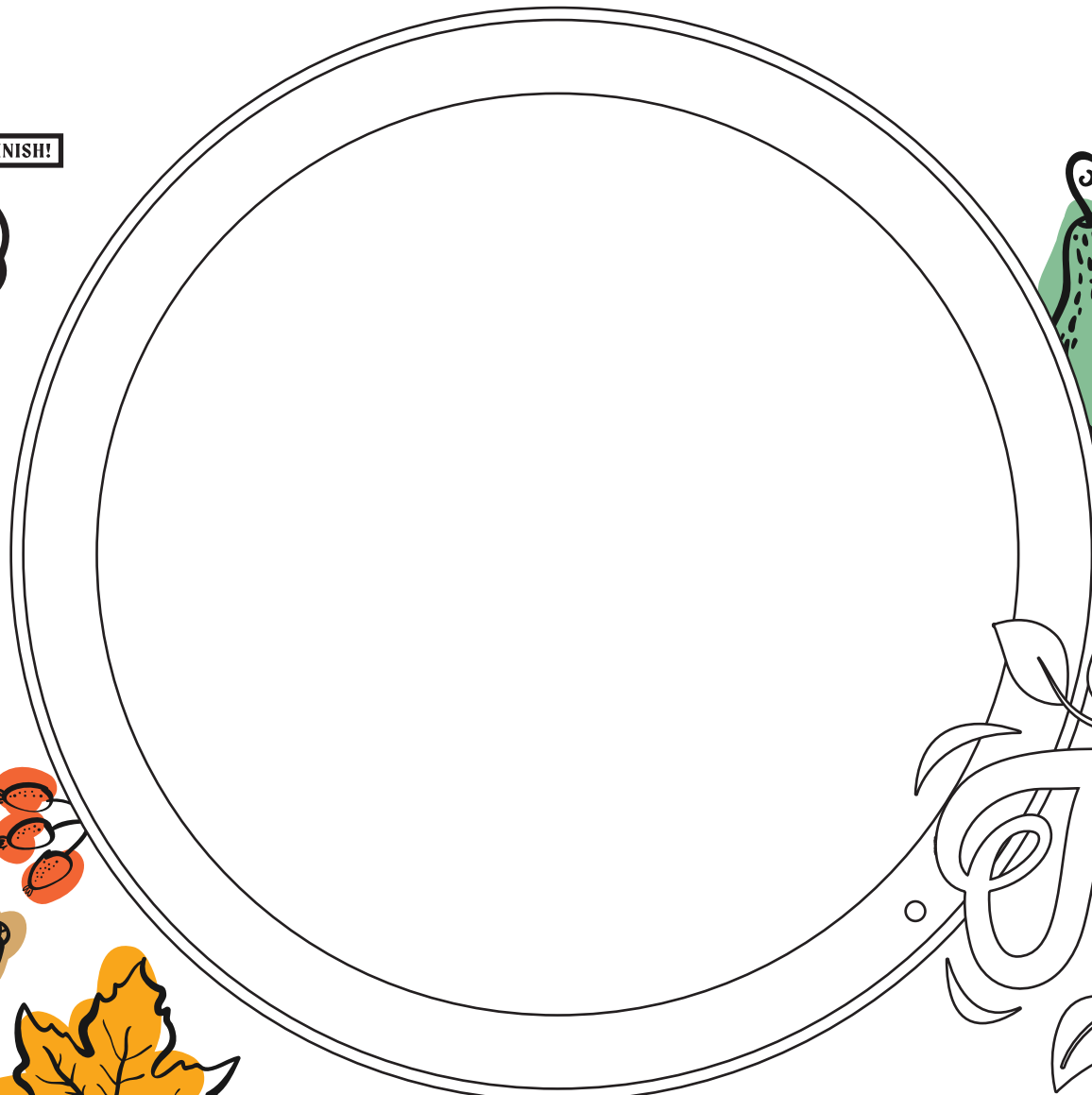
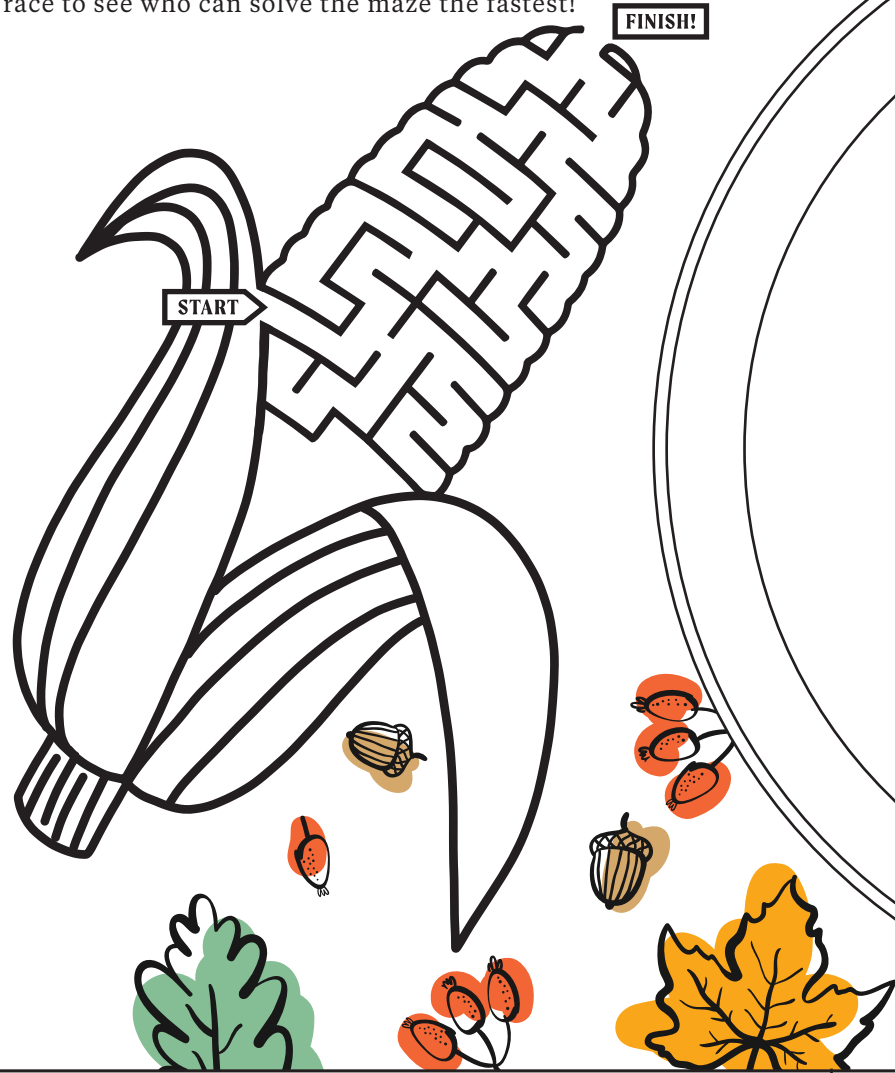


# Corn Maze
